James Head served one term as Sheriff from 1840 – 42

Not much is known about the family history of Sheriff Head. However, it is believed he married Bonelera A. Callaway on September 9, 1833.

James Head was appointed as the Deputy Sheriff under James Love along with James W. Crockett.

James W. Crockett was Sheriff Head's deputy while he was in office and Mathias Gahagen was listed as a Jailor.

James lived on the Towaliga River near Burnt Mill in Henry County.

James was appointed Sheriff in 1840 through 1842.
