HB845 states when an individual requests a booking photograph, that the individual 'shall' submit a statement affirming that the photograph will not be placed in a publication or placed on a website that requires a fee for removal of the said photograph. Therefore, <u>any individual</u>, whether it's a private citizen, a representative of a media organization, or representative of any business, must sign an affirmation statement. This is a "one time blanket" statement for multiple requests per Sheriff Keith McBrayer.
